Key amenities include:

- Chisholm Aquatics Center featuring a spacious main pool, lazy river, and multiple slides
- ~30-foot-tall water slide tower with 3 slides
- 5 shaded pavilions and 2.7-acre outdoor aquatics site
- Central Aquatics Center with a zero-depth leisure pool, spray features, and children's activity areas
- 2 lap lanes for swim programming and training
- Shaded pavilions and cabanas for rentals
- Learn-to-Swim programs for ages 6 months to 8 years
- Special events including Dive-In Movies, Sensory-Friendly Swim, Play Safe: Drowning Prevention, and Doggie Dive-In
- Concessions at both centers

This principle keeps us honest as leaders and as teammates. It removes blame, adds structure, and ensures no one is blindsided. When we follow Right by Three, we build trust at every level of the organization.

Let's commit to always improving and growing over time.

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RIGHT BY THREE

• How we handle shortcomings & performance issues:

- The first infraction is owned by the Leader. Responsibility to communicate clearly and directly.
- The second infraction is owned by the Team Member. Responsibility to fully understand expectations.
- The third necessitates change. Scale of change varies based on the shortcoming.
